Our Independence Day, July 4th

Here are some words to ponder on this year's Independence Day:

"I believe in the United States of America as a government of the people, by the people, and for the people, whose just powers are derived from the consent of the governed; a democracy in a Republic; a sovereign Nation of many sovereign States; a perfect Union, one and inseparable; established upon those principles of freedom, equality, justice, and humanity for which American patriots sacrificed their lives and fortunes.

"I therefore believe it is my duty to my Country to love it; to support its Constitution; to obey its laws; to respect its flag; and to defend it against all enemies."

That's "The American's Creed," written in 1917 by William Tyler Page, an employee of the Capitol Building in Washington, D.C., as an entry in a writing contest shortly after the United States entered World War I. The judges selected Page's entry out of thousands because, in just 100 words, he gave "the best summary of the political faith of America."

Page incorporated passages and phrases from the Declaration of Independence, the Preamble to the Constitution, and Abraham Lincoln's Gettysburg Address. Congress officially adopted the Creed on April 13, 1918.

Keep Tires Inflated to Save Gas

The Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co. estimates that under-inflated tires waste four million gallons of gas daily in the United States. Let us check your tires once a month or use your own pressure gauge because air meters at gas stations can be inaccurate. You should have each tire inflated to the pressure recommended in the owner's manual.

Bavarian Ice Cream Treat

Try this recipe for an unusual mix of sweet, salty, smooth, chewy, crunchy, cold, and warm sensations:

1 pint vanilla ice cream

1 cup flaked coconut (unsweetened is best).

1 cup salted peanuts, chopped

Warm chocolate sauce

Slightly thaw ice cream and stir in coconut. Form into balls (about the size of a tennis ball), and roll in the peanuts, covering completely. Place in a flat dish or layer up in a plastic container, using wax paper to separate the layers. Put in the freezer for an hour or so to let the ice cream re-harden. Serve with warm chocolate sauce. Makes about nine.

Check The Back Seat Before Leaving The Car

Certainly you would never intentionally leave a baby, child or pet locked in the car when the weather is hot, or anytime. Within 10 minutes, the temperature in a car can cause a heat stroke.

But you could be very busy or preoccupied. A sleeping child in the back seat could be forgotten. The CDC recommends placing a stuffed animal on the front seat to help you remember. Always check to see that everyone is out of the car before leaving it.

Leave pets at home. Move your pet into the air conditioned house or at least move them into the shade. Be sure there is plenty of water available.

America's First 18-Hole Golf Course

On July 18, 1893, the country's first 18-hole golf course opened at the Chicago Golf Club in Wheaton, IL. Charles Blair MacDonald, a Scottish-American, designed it based on Scottish and English courses. He believed that golfers should face a hazard at every hole.

The first permanent golf club in the United States was the St. Andrews Golf Club. It was established five years earlier in Yonkers, N.Y., with six holes. By 1900, the United States had 982 golf courses, and today, that number has grown to more than 4,500.

Get Maximum Coverage From Your Sunscreen

The American Academy of Dermatologists recommends slathering on two tablespoons of sunscreen, the equivalent of a shot glass, per extended outing during the summer months. Be sure to cover the nose, ears, neck, shoulders, and the tops of your feet. Don't wait until you're outside either, apply it inside and allow 20 minutes for your skin to soak in the sunscreen.
