Memorial Day, May 29th

This year will mark the 82nd anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, which killed 2,400 American soldiers, sailors, and airmen. Every year, more than 1.6 million people visit the USS Arizona Memorial, which is accessed by boats from the naval base. The seemingly floating structure houses the bell of the sunken battleship Arizona, whose wreckage can be seen from a viewing port inside the memorial. At the far end of the memorial is a marble wall that has the names of the fallen servicemen etched in bronze lettering.

Rose (pink): sweetness


Rose (red): true love, desire
